## Friday, September 25, 2020

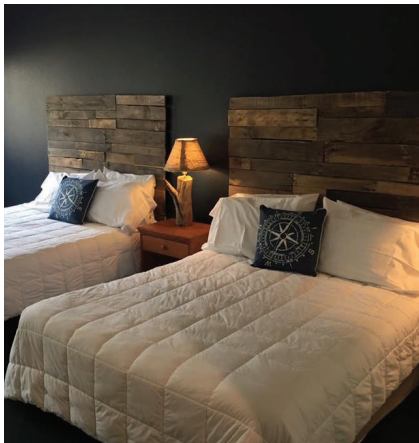
